

Street Parking ORDINANCE 297 – 1980

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING ON CITY STREETS DURING SNOW REMOVAL SEASON AND PROVIDING FOR REMOVAL OF ANY PERSONAL PROPERTY NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THIS ORDINANCE. ALSO PROVIDING PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY.

SECTION I:

No person shall cause any personal property or vehicle to be parked on any City street or any public property during any snowstorm or for twenty four (24) hours after any snow storm.

SECTION II:

Vehicles or personal property not in compliance with this ordinance can be towed away, and can be claimed only by payment of towing fees.

SECTION III:

Owners of illegally parked property can be cited and fined \$100.00 for each day and each offense.
