AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF PARIS, IDAHO, SETTING FORTH A MORATORIUM ON WATER CONNECTIONS AND LIMITING PERMITS TO 7 PER YEAR; WAIVING THE RULE THAT THIS ORDINANCE BE READ ON THREE SEPARATE OCCASIONS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE 601 - 2023

WHEREAS the City has determined there is a water storage and supply shortage within the water systems of the City; and

WHEREAS the City finds the water shortage to be an imminent peril to the public health, safety and welfare of the Citizens as the City cannot meet the standards for fire suppression, water pressure, and water supply services to the growing number of Citizens requesting the same;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARIS, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

Pursuant to Idaho Code 67-6523, the City of Paris, Idaho hereby imposes a moratorium limiting new water connections with a building permit for the City to seven per year. The issuance of water connection permits shall be granted on a first come, first served basis. The commencement of the aforesaid limitation shall be the date of the passage of this ordinance.

Section 2:

The City waives the multiple readings of this Ordinance.

Section 3:

This Ordinance shall be in force as of the date of passage.
